INTELLIGENT TRANSPORT SYSTEMS (ITS) Forum 2017

Last February 17, 2017, De La Salle University - Manila (DLSU - Manila) hosted the Intelligent Transport Systems (ITS) Forum 2017 at the 5th floor Henry Sy Sr. Hall. It was sponsored by the Philippine Council for Industry, Energy and Emerging Technology Research and Development of the Department of Science and Technology (P-CIEERD-DOST), DLSU-Manila, UP-National Center for Transportation Studies (NCTS), and Transportation Science Society of the Philippines (TSSP). The forum was attended by representatives of different agencies from the public and private sectors.



The government agencies that were represented in the forum were the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), Department of Public Works and Highways (DPWH), Metropolitan Manila Development Authority (MMDA), and Department of Transportation (DOTr). Private bus companies and local organizations such as the Manila Traffic and Parking Bureau also sent representatives. The academic community included the University of the Philippines (UP), DLSU, and the Mapua Institute of Technology (MIT).

The ITS forum showcased the various ITS research projects of the various academic institutions all under PCIEERD-DOST. The research projects yielded significant and interesting results.
